

## Gammarus

Materials:

Hook:	Kamasan B100 8-12 TMC 2487 8-12
Thread:	Black 08
Body:	Hare grey and amber
Ribbing:	Leader nylon .18 Fine copper wire
Body cover:	Transparent latex
Weighing:	Flat lead wire



- 1 Wind 5-6 turns of lead wire around the hook shank



- 2 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook  
3 Wind the thread into the curvature of the hook and back to the eye to secure the lead wire



- 4 Tie in the leader nylon and secure it down into the curvature of the hook



- 5 Tie in the copper wire and secure it down into the curvature of the hook



- 6 Form a dubbing loop  
7 Insert grey hare dubbing in the loop and twist



- 8 Wind the rear part of the body

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- 9 Insert amber dubbing in a dubbing loop, twist and wind the thorax



- 10 Wind the copper wire as a first ribbing to the eye of the hook



- 11 Tie in a strip of transparent latex at the eye of the hook



- 12 Flip the latex over the back of the fly into the curvature of the hook

- 13 Secure the latex with a turn of leader nylon

- 14 Wind the leader nylon as a second ribbing to the eye of the hook



- 15 Wind the head

- 16 Whipfinish

- 17 Pull on the latex strip and cut off the excess

- 18 Brush out the dubbing



- 19 Add a drop of black head cement
