

Flamethrower

Materials:


Hook:	Partridge CS14/2B 7-15
Thread:	Black 8/0
Rear Body:	Silver holographic tinsel
Ribbing:	Twisted copper wire
1 st hackle:	Orange coq feather
Front body:	Black floss
Ribbing:	Twisted copper wire
Wing:	Orange fox and pearl crystal flash
Front hackle:	Yellow coq over orange cock
Cheeks:	Jungle coq
Head:	Pearl crystal flash




- 1 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook
- 2 Wind the thread to the curvature of the hook



- 3 Tie in the twisted ribbing wire




- 4 Tie in the tinsel at the center of the hook shank
- 5 Wind the tinsel to the beginning of the curvature and then back to the middle of the hook shank



- 6 Wind the ribbing wire to the middle of the hook shank



7 Tie in an orange coq hackle



8 Wind 2 turns with the coq hackle



9 Tie in the ribbing wire

10 Wind the thread to the eye of the hook



11 Tie in the black floss



12 Wind the floss to the middle of the hook shank and back to the eye of the hook

13 Wind the ribbing wire to the eye of the hook



14 Tie in a bunch of fox hair with the tips of the hair extending over the eye of the hook



15 Flip back the fox hair and secure it in this position



16 Tie in 2 strands of pearl crystal flash



17 Tie in a second bunch of fox hair on top of the first bunch and the crystal flash



18 Tie in an orange coq feather



19 Wind a 2 turns hackle with the orange coq feather



20 Tie in an yellow coq feather



21 Wind a 2 turns hackle with the yellow coq feather



22 Tie in 2 jungle coq feather as cheeks

23 Tie in a strand of pearl crystal flash

24 Whipfinish

25 Apply a drop of instant glue behind the eye of the hook



26 Wind the head with the crystal flash



27 Apply a drop of UV glue to the head

28 Cure the UV glue with your UV torch
