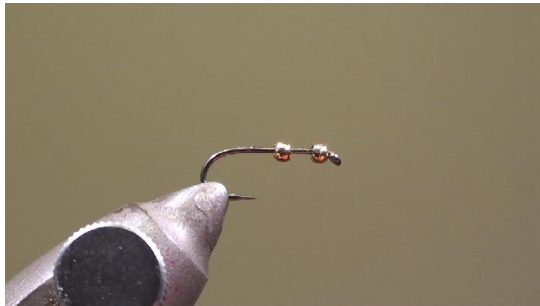


Hotspot Pheasant Tail

Materials:

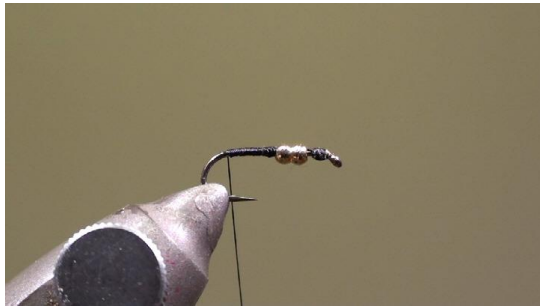
Hook:	TMC100 12-18 Kamasan B400 12-18
Thread:	Black 8/0
Beads:	Brass 3mm-1.5mm
Hotspot:	Unistretch orange
Tail:	Pheasant tail fibers
Body & Thorax:	Pheasant tail fibers
Plus	UV glue Instant glue



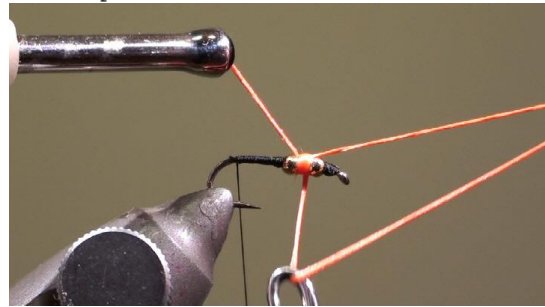
1 Insert 2 brass beads on the hook, the conical boreholes facing each other



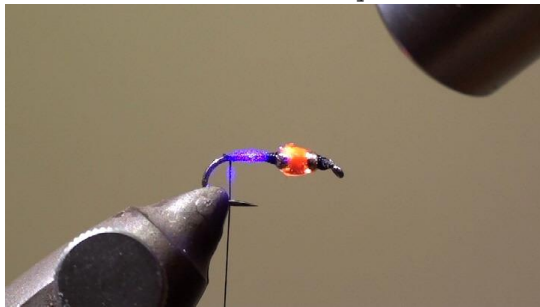
2 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook
3 Wind head
4 Whipfinish



5 Tie in the thread behind the second bead
6 Wind a bed for the fly



7 Tie in the orange Unistretch between the beads
8 Fill the gap and whipfinish



9 Apply some UV glue on the Thorax and cure it with the UV torch



10 Tie in some 10 pheasant tail fibers as a tail

11 Wind the bunch of fibers forwards to the rear bead

12 Tie them off above the hook shank

13 Whipfinish and cut off the thread



14 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook



15 Flip the pheasant tail fibers over the thorax to the eye of the hook

16 Secure them with a couple of windings



17 Cut off the excess of fibers



18 Apply a drop of instant glue on the thread



19 Wind the final head

20 Cut off the thread
