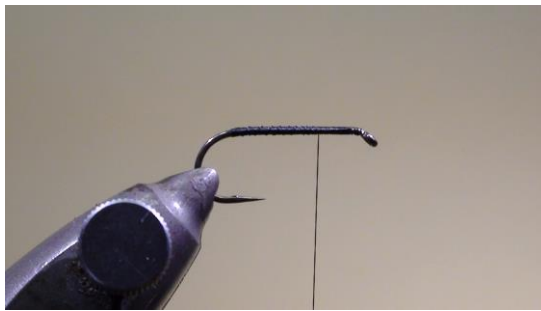


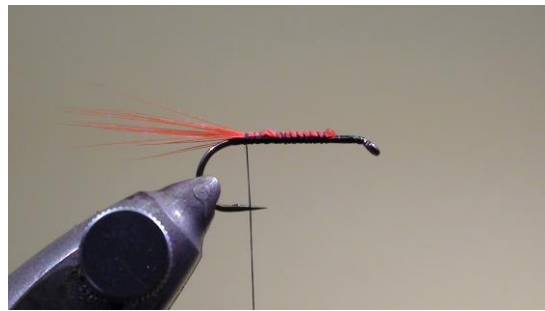
Buzz Hackle

Materials:

Hook:	TMC100 8-12 Kamasan B400 8-12
Thread:	Black 8/0
Tail:	Red cock feather tips
Rear Hackle:	Grizzly cock feather
Body:	Silver Mylar small & Peacock
Front Hackle:	Brown cock feather



- 1 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook
- 2 Wind it in close turns to the bend
- 3 Wind the thread back to the eye



- 4 Tie in a bunch of red cock feather tips as a tail
- 5 Secure the feather tips over the whole shank length



- 6 Tie in a large grizzly cock hackle



- 7 Tie in the silver Mylar film



- 8 Cover a little bit less than 1/3 of the hook shank with the Mylar film



- 9 Wind the grizzly feather as a hackle over the Mylar film



- 10 Flip 2 peacock herls from the back around the tying thread
11 Secure with a few turns on top of the hook shank
12 Make a dubbing loop



- 13 Wind the thread to the eye of the hook
14 Twist the herls together with the dubbing loop



- 15 Wind the center part of the body



- 16 Tie in a medium sized brown cock feather



- 17 Tie in the silver Mylar film



- 18 Cover the front 1/3 of the hook shank with the Mylar film



- 19 Wind the brown feather as a hackle over the Mylar film



- 20 Wind the head of the fly
21 Whipfinish
22 Secure the windings with a drop of black head cement
