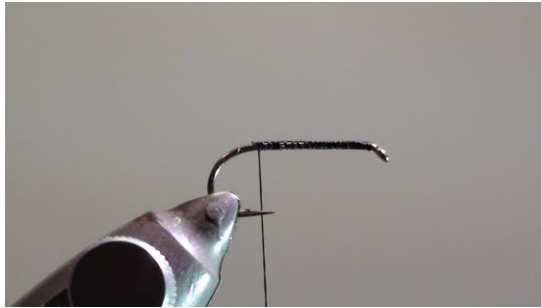


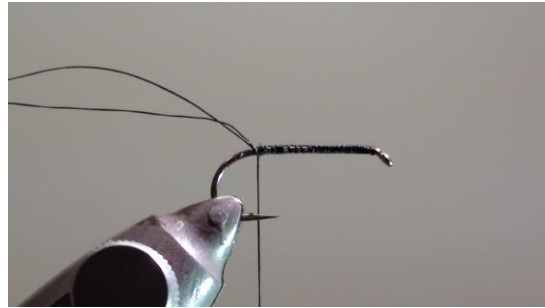
Buck Caddis

Materials:

Hook:	TMC100 10-12 Kamasan B400 10-12
Thread:	Black 8/0
Body:	Ice Dubbing green
Ribbing:	CDC light blue
Wing:	Deer hair



- 1 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook
- 2 Wind it in close turns to the beginning of the curvature of the hook



- 3 Make a dubbing loop
- 4 Clamp the dubbing loop in the materials clamp of your vise



- 5 Twist some Ice dubbing onto the tying thread
- 6 Wind the body of the fly



- 7 Cut off or tear of the excessive dubbing





- 8 Insert the fiber tips of one CDC feather into the dubbing loop
- 9 Twist the loop to secure the fiber tips



- 10 Wind the twisted CDC loop as a ribbing to the eye of the hook
- 11 Secure the loop
- 12 Cut off the excess



- 13 Tie in a bunch of Deer hair as a wing



- 14 Wind the head of the fly
- 15 Whipfinish
