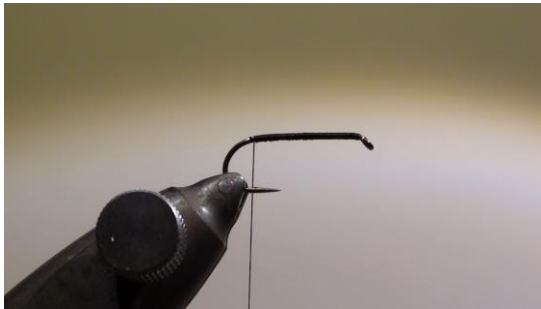


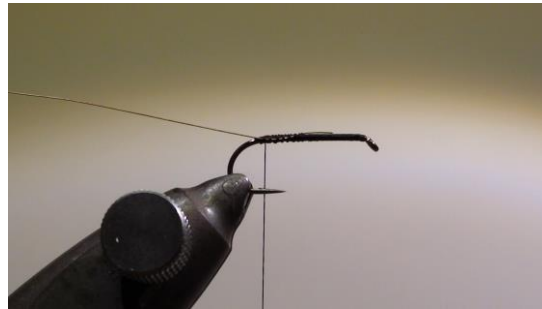
## Wet Bibio

### Materials:

Hook:	TMC 100 #10-16 or Kamasan B400 #10-16
Thread:	Black 8/0
Body:	Seals fur black red black
Ribbing:	Copper wire
Body Hackle:	Black cock feather small
Legs:	Knotted pheasant tail fibers
Head Hackle:	Black cock feather large
Head:	Thread and UV Head cement or black head cement



1 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook and wind it in close turns to the beginning of curvature of the hook



2 Tie in the ribbing wire



3 Make a Dubbing loop

4 Wind the tying thread to the eye of the hook



5 Insert a bunch of black seals fur in the dubbing loop followed by a bunch of red and another bunch of black seals fur.

6 Secure the seals fur by twisting the loop.

7 Wind the body of the fly



8 Tie in a small black cock feather at the eye of the hook

9 Wind the feather to the beginning of the curvature of the hook



10 Secure the feather with the ribbing wire

11 Wind the wire to the eye of the hook and tie it off



12 Tie in 2 pairs of legs on each side of the hook shank.



13 Tie in a larger cock feather at the eye of the hook



14 Wind the head hackle



15 Tie off the hackle

16 Wind the head of the fly



17 Whipfinish



18 Add a drop of black head cement or UV glue on the head of the fly
