

Stillwater Nymph

Hook	TMC5262 or TMC5263 #8-12
Thread	Black 8/0
Tail	Pear or silver Christalflash Light green Marabou
Body	Grey Rabbit Dubbing
Body Hackle	Grizzly cock feather
Body Cover	Light green Marabou
Plus	Fine lead wire



1. Wind 10-15 turns of fine lead wire around the hook shank
2. Secure the windings with a drop of instant glue



3. Tie-in the thread at the eye of the hook and wind it in close turns to the beginning of the curvature of the hook



4. Tie in 6-8 strands of Chrystalflash



5. Tie in a good bunch of Marabou feather tips to create a long tail



6. Tie in a second bunch of Marabou feather tips with the tips



8. Twist some dark grey dubbing onto your thread



10. Wind the feather in direction of the eye making sure that the last windings will be tighter



12. Flip the Marabou feather tips (the ones that you have tied in with the tips) to the eye
13. Tie them off

7. Tie in a grizzly cock feather with its tip



9. Wind the body of the fly with the dubbed thread



11. Cut off the cock feather tips on the upper side of the body



14. Wind the head of the fly
15. Apply a drop of instant glue to the head
